Short Notes

Payment of Sick Days – This is the first year that sick days will be paid out at the end of the year. If you are lucky enough to have some left, look for them on your July 15 pay!

Teacher Federal Tax Credit – Don't forget that the Federal government has established a new tax credit of up to \$1000 for teachers who reach into their pockets to pay for classroom items. Keep your receipts so you can claim them on next year's taxes.

Reminders about Insurance Coverage for Retirees and Part-time Teachers

Part-time teachers whose contracts expired prior to June 1st will cease to be covered as of the last day for which premiums have been paid.

Part time teachers whose contracts expire on June 1st or later will be covered until September 30th, 2017. This is to ensure insurance continuity should they be rehired. If they are rehired, extra premiums will be deducted to cover any premiums that may be missing. If they are not rehired, no action will be taken to recover the lost premiums.

Retiring teachers will be covered until August 31st as in the past. They should be enrolled in the retiree plan as of September 1st.
